## New entry requirements for Abu Dhabi emirate from Sunday, 8 November

Negative test result

PCR or DPI



First 48 hours



1 Take a COVID-19 test

2 > Entry to the emirate within 48 hours of receiving the test result

Day four

Day eight

3 PCR test is mandatory on the 4th day of entering

> only when staying for 4 or more consecutive days

4 PCR test is mandatory on the 8th day of entering

> only when staying for 8 or more consecutive days, in addition to the test on day 4

Rule applies to all UAE citizens and residents, including returning Abu Dhabi residents

Those failing to take the PCR test on day 4 and 8 are liable for fines

Volunteers in the COVID-19 vaccine trials and those taking the vaccine under the emergency use programme are exempt from these measures and are authorised to use emergency vehicle lanes for a smooth journey

The day of arrival into Abu Dhabi is counted as day 1

### Example:

If entering Abu Dhabi on Sunday (day 1) and staying for 4 or more days, a PCR test is mandatory on Wednesday (day 4). If staying for 8 or more consecutive days, a PCR test is mandatory on Wednesday as well as on the following Sunday (day 8)
