Actions	Short Description	Organization	Employees	Visitors	Gov
1. Health and Hygiene	<p>1. Staff : Employers to ensure that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All health & safety guidelines/standards are followed in staff accommodation & transport facilities in line with DM Health & Safety Guidelines [“DMHS”] All protocols prescribed by DMHS must be adhered to - prior to staff entering the premises “for Public Interaction” Mandatory temperature checks for all onsite staff Compulsory wearing of masks for staff who are “in Direct Contact with Customers” and for kitchen and clean up staff, masks and gloves are compulsory as well. Pre-shift briefings to be held virtually wherever possible. <p>2. Disinfection/sanitisation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prior to Opening: Thorough sterilization of all assets/furniture to be done within timelines as prescribed by DMHS prior to opening. Sanitise high throughput areas, toilet and regular touch points including door handles, table tops etc... post use or at minimum once every hour. Sanitise bar tops every hour and table surfaces immediately after use Full sterilization post closure of venue daily. <p>3. Screening:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Venue entrances to have contactless screening for guests, visitors & contractors based on DMHS guidelines. Every guest should be screened while entering/re-entering the venue. <p>4. Venues guidelines:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All venues should adhere to the guideline issued separately based on the business activity 	CR	CR	CM	R
2. Social Distancing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All staff to practice social distancing guidelines across the operating facility as required by DM guidelines. Crowding is not allowed in all areas (eg spectators, dancing etc) Bar counter stools are not allowed to be used by guests. No queuing allowed outside the venue, and waiting area inside the venue is not permitted. 	CR	CR	CM	R

General Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Any indoor sports activities e.g. pool tables, darts etc should follow Dubai Sports Council and Dubai Municipality guidelines. ▪ Single entertainer/performer to perform on dedicated stage only and no physical interaction is permitted with audiences. ▪ Minimum of 2m distance between performance areas and audiences [including seated/standing areas] ▪ crowding is not allowed in all areas (eg spectators, dancing etc) ▪ Moving heads , flashes and clubbing ambiance is not allowed ▪ Ensure the venue is sufficiently lit at all times ▪ Compulsory wearing of masks for all entertainers at all times 	CR	CR	CM	R
